2. ESERA 2021 – online Fostering scientific citizenship in an uncertain world The network coordinators reminded everyone of the upcoming ESERA conference and that it has been decided that it will be an online conference.





We strongly urged SIG2 members to serve as referees for proposals of workshops/symposia etc. to actively support the ESERA community (email about this info came from ESERA on 1 Nov).

We highlighted from the ESERA conference description that presenters will be requested to record their presentation and send these to the conference secretariat until the deadline, which will be informed well in advance. Recorded presentations will be uploaded to the Conference Programme before the conference dates allowing registered participants to consult the presentations online in advance. Conference sessions are organised in Strands in the online Conference Programme. Single paper sessions and Symposia will also include real-time moderated interactive Q&A between attending participants and the presenters.

3. Organisation of an invited SIG symposium at the ESERA conference 2021

- that we would like to hold the invited symposium and maybe also a workshop
- ESERA regulations requires we need a min of 3 countries/max 4 presentations
- Sarah (with support) will prepare the draft for the call for the invited SIG (due 15 January 2021). The main idea is that we will focus on contributors receiving one or two videos and transcripts and then apply their own selected frameworks.
- Kathrin and Hannah will consider drafting a workshop with a focus on remote learning through video in science education (collecting ideas of hope through the rapid interventions all teachers had to engage in)
